Ticket sales as well as membership dues are small portion of budget should focus on other sources of revenue rather than raise these costs to singers
- ROS does not receive donation from City (other groups, e.g. Greece Choral society, receive local donations Town of Greece); Rochester City Arts & Cultural Council may be possible source of donation
