- Exciting month for ROS!
- ROS has won grants: second Humanities Grant, \$1,000 Capacity Grant purchase of thermal printer through grant / budget, grant from State insures ROS on NYS Community Calendar
- Engagement with Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra in December 2018 two large pieces, week of December 11-18, two performances Thursday and Saturday, ten weeks preparation time
- Four Monday rehearsals after April 20, 2018 concert to prepare for fall first concert October 7; funds approved for these rehearsals, accompanist; open rehearsals could serve as recruitment for ROS
